



### **Green Career Opportunity – Green Collar Corps**

The Watershed Project's *Green Collar Corps (GCC)* student worker program is made for college students looking for hands-on work experience in the environmental field. It is a great way to explore STEM careers while gaining valuable job skills and educational opportunities, while working side by side with environmental professionals. GCC fellows work in hands-on projects both in the field and in the office, and on a personalized project based on their own interests. Frequent educational trainings in the environmental field offer exposure to a wide variety of options in this exciting field.

This is a paid, part-time position of 12-16 hours a week, designed to accommodate college courses.

#### *Areas of Focus:*

**Greening Urban Watersheds:** Help us restore natural function to our city landscapes and assist us in planting and maintaining green infrastructure projects, leading volunteer events, and community outreach.

**Outreach:** Help connect East Bay residents with the watershed movement. This focus area is perfect for anyone interested in environmental writing, communications and marketing, and/or community organizing.

**Watershed Education:** Support our education team in planning and teaching out award-winning watershed curriculum to students of all ages.

**Healthy Watersheds:** Work with our Healthy Watersheds team to assist with volunteer outreach and publicity for community events.

**Wild Shorelines:** Get involved in the restoration of native oysters and educating the local community about their connection to the shoreline.

**Communications:** This focus area is great for anyone who is passionate about environmental issues and interested in learning about how a small non-profit works.

**Development:** Work with our development team on fundraising endeavors, including researching grant opportunities, grant writing, soliciting in-kind donations, cultivating corporate sponsorships, individual donations, and planning special events.
